The Kingdom in Power

1 Corinthians 4:20 - For the kingdom of God is not in word but in power.

Mark 9:1 - And He said to them, "Assuredly, I say to you that there are some standing here who will not taste death till they see the kingdom of God present with power."

• This could only refer to the outpouring of the Holy Spirit occurring on the Jewish feast called Pentecost, recorded in Acts 2:1-4

¹ On the day of Pentecost all the believers were meeting together in one place. ² Suddenly, there was a sound from heaven like the roaring of a mighty windstorm, and it filled the house where they were sitting. ³ Then, what looked like flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each of them. ⁴ And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages,* as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability. (NLT)

So, we see the Holy Spirit IS the power of God.

Where & how God expresses His power:

- Three realities, described in 1 Thessalonians. 5:23 Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole **spirit**, **soul**, and **body** be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
 - We are made in the image of God in this regard
- Spirit is the highest reality, followed by soul, then body.
 - Soul is our personality, emotions, will, etc.

The Holy Spirit exerts His power to the material world

Creation

Heb. 11:3

By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible. (ESV)

Gen. 1:1,2

¹ In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. ² The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. **And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.**

I mention this because we will see a pattern here of how the Holy Spirit works with the spoken Word of God.

The Bible says that Jesus "upholds the universe by the word of his power" (Heb. 1:3, ESV)

The force that holds protons and neutrons together must be very strong. Well, in a brilliant stroke of imagination, physicists have named this force "the strong force."

• John 3:3-5

³ Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God." ⁴ Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" ⁵ Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. ⁶ That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. So, this is Spirit to spirit.

Like the original creation, the new creation is a result of the Holy Spirit, Who is now hovering over humanity, responding to the Word of God. John 5:24

John 14:15-18

¹⁵ "If you love Me, keep My commandments. ¹⁶ And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may abide with you forever—¹⁷ the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you and will be in you. ¹⁸ I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you.

For all His power and ability, the Holy Spirit is not just an experience. He is a Person. We will look in more depth next week at His role in our lives.
